

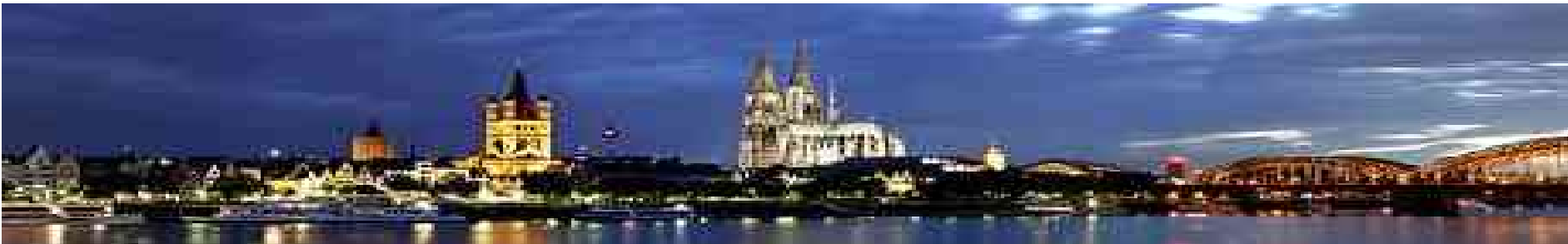

- Germany's most famous landmark: the Dom
- Renowned modern art museums, historical museums, and churches
- Known as a tolerant city, Cologne hosts the annual Carnival, Christopher Street Day festival, Summerjam (reggae festival), city- wide rock concerts, ...
- WDR's Radio Symphony Orchestra resides in the Philharmony, a masterpiece of architecture and acoustics
